

## CEDAR FRAMED WELCOME SIGN AT ENTRY



## MATERIALS

- \* Welcome Sign
- \* 4X4 7' Cedar Post
- \* (4) 2x6 Pre Cut Cedar Boards
- \* (2) Pre Cut 2x4 Cedar Braces
- \* (2) Pre Cut 2x2 Cedar Braces
- \* (2) Bags Concrete
- \* 2" Lag Bolts and Washers
- \* 3" Wood Screws
- \* Drill
- \* Post Hole Digger
- \* Shovel
- \* Wheelbarrow
- \* Level





- 2. Place notched 2x6 on post. See figure one.
- 3. Place boards on sides and top. Top board has equal overhang on each side. See Figure two.
- 4. Attach sign to post at top and bottom using washers and 2" lag bolts.
- 5. Using wood screws assemble frame. Attaching in two places per joint. Drill pilot holes if necessary.
- 6. Brace bottom notched 2x6 on each side of the post with 2x4 wood pieces.
- 7. Turn sign over and place 2x2 braces at edge of sign adjacent to 2x6. Attach 2x2 braces to 2x6 frame.
- 8. Dig one hole 24" deep, see stake for location
- 9. Place the 4x4 post in the hole and pour mixed concrete around the post. Level.




Figure two
